

CONSTRUCTION REPORT for Water Recreation Facility

As outlined in **Chapter 246-260-021 WAC**, upon completion of Water Recreation Facility (WRF) pool facility construction, modification or alteration and before use, owners shall submit to the Snohomish County Health Department (SCHD) a construction report signed by an Engineer or Architect certifying that the construction is substantially in compliance with approved plans and specification and related to conditions under WAC 246-260. The person signing the construction report shall confirm the mechanical equipment and circulation system is substantially installed and functioning in accordance with the approved plan, and the facility with provisions for diving substantially confirms with the diving envelope requirements established in the regulation.

The person signing the construction report shall also confirm that the walking surfaces, barriers, pool components (including piping), inlets, outlets, dimensional design, pool appurtenances, equipment rooms, ventilation, and lighting and plumbing fixtures are substantially in conformance with the approved plans.
