## **Spa Pool Rules**

- ❖ Persons refusing to obey rules are subject to removal from premises.
- ❖ When lifeguards or attendants are not present:
  - Children age 12 and under must be supervised at the spa pool facility by a responsible adult (age 18 and over) at all times the child is at the spa pool; and
  - Persons age 13-17 must not use spa pool alone.
- ❖ Health Advisory:
  - Children under age 6 should not use spa pool.
  - Persons suffering from heart disease, diabetes, or high blood pressure should consult a physician before using spa pool.
  - Women who are or might be pregnant should seek physician's advice regarding use of spa pool.
  - Persons with seizure, heart or circulatory problems are advised to swim with a buddy.
  - Spa users should limit the stay in the spa pool to fifteen minutes at any one session.
  - If you have a communicable disease that can be transmitted by water or have been ill with diarrhea or vomiting in the last two weeks, do not use the spa pool.
- ❖ No running on deck or horseplay in the spa pool area.
- ❖ Do not use spa pool when under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- ❖ Cleansing shower required before using the spa pool.
- ❖ Persons wearing diapers are required to have protective coverings such as tight fitting rubber pants, and changed in designated area.
- ❖ Food or drink is prohibited in the spa pool.
