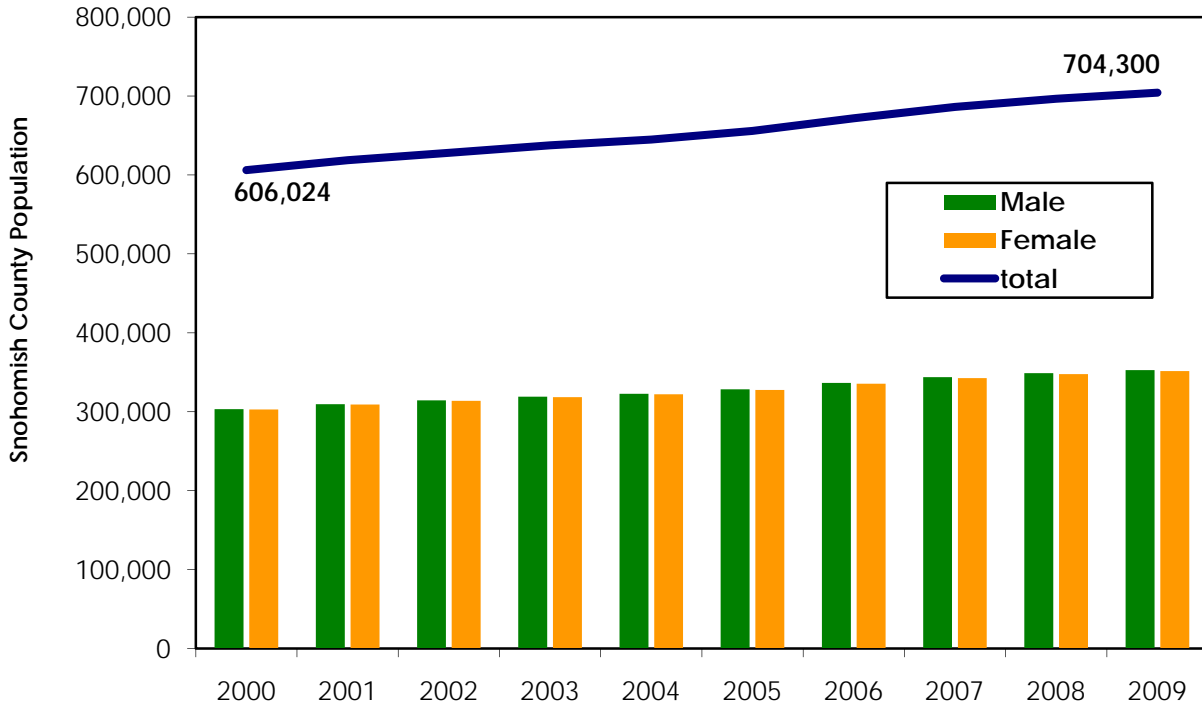


Population Estimates¹ Snohomish County & Washington State, 2000 - 2009

- From 2000 through 2009, the Snohomish County population increased by 16.2% (an increase of 98,276 people) compared with a Washington State population increase of 13.1% (an increase of 774,079 people). Of the Snohomish County increase, 43,244 (44.0%) was due to the natural increase in population (births minus deaths), and 55,032 (56.0%) was due to migration.
- From 2000 through 2009, Snohomish County was the sixth fastest growing county in WA State.²
