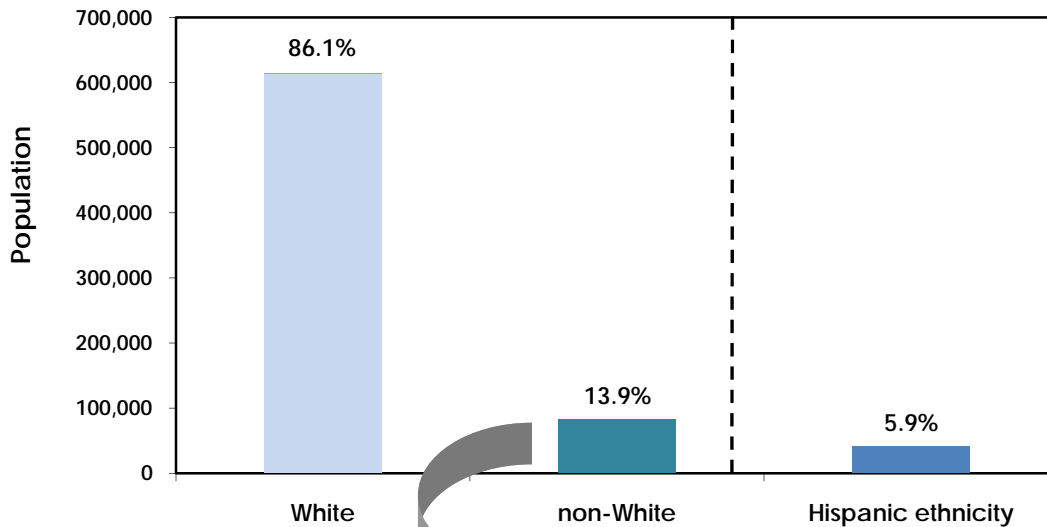


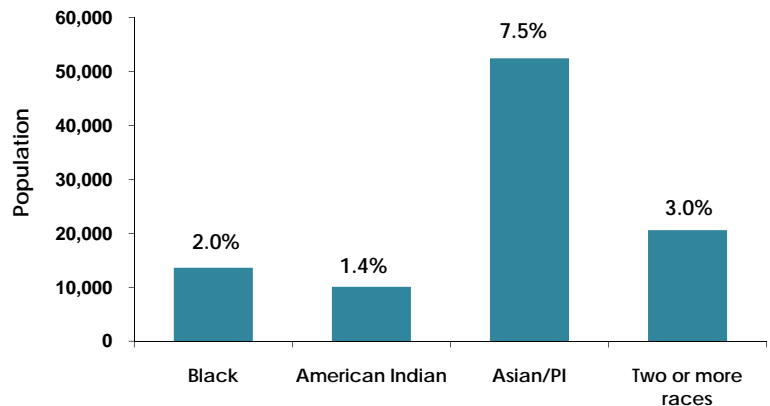
Population by Race and Hispanic Ethnicity¹ Snohomish County & Washington State, 2008
