Figure 1: Snohomish County COVID-19 case rates per 100,000

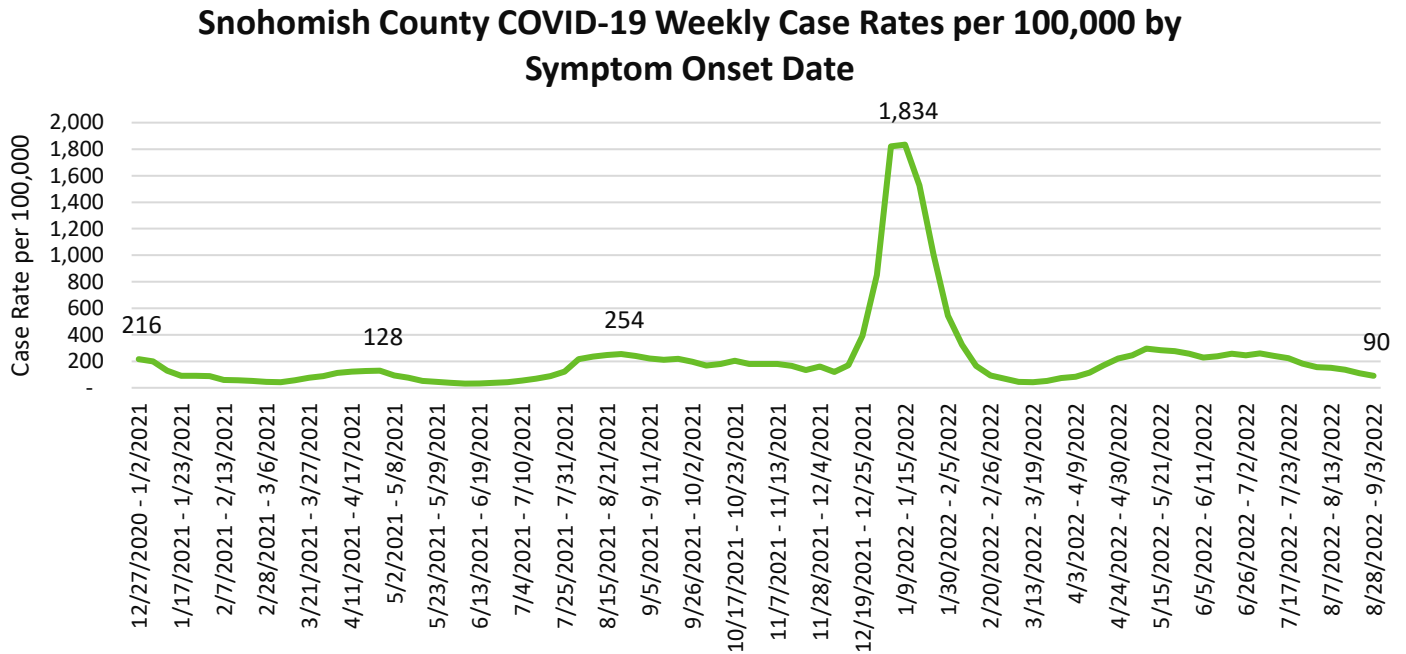
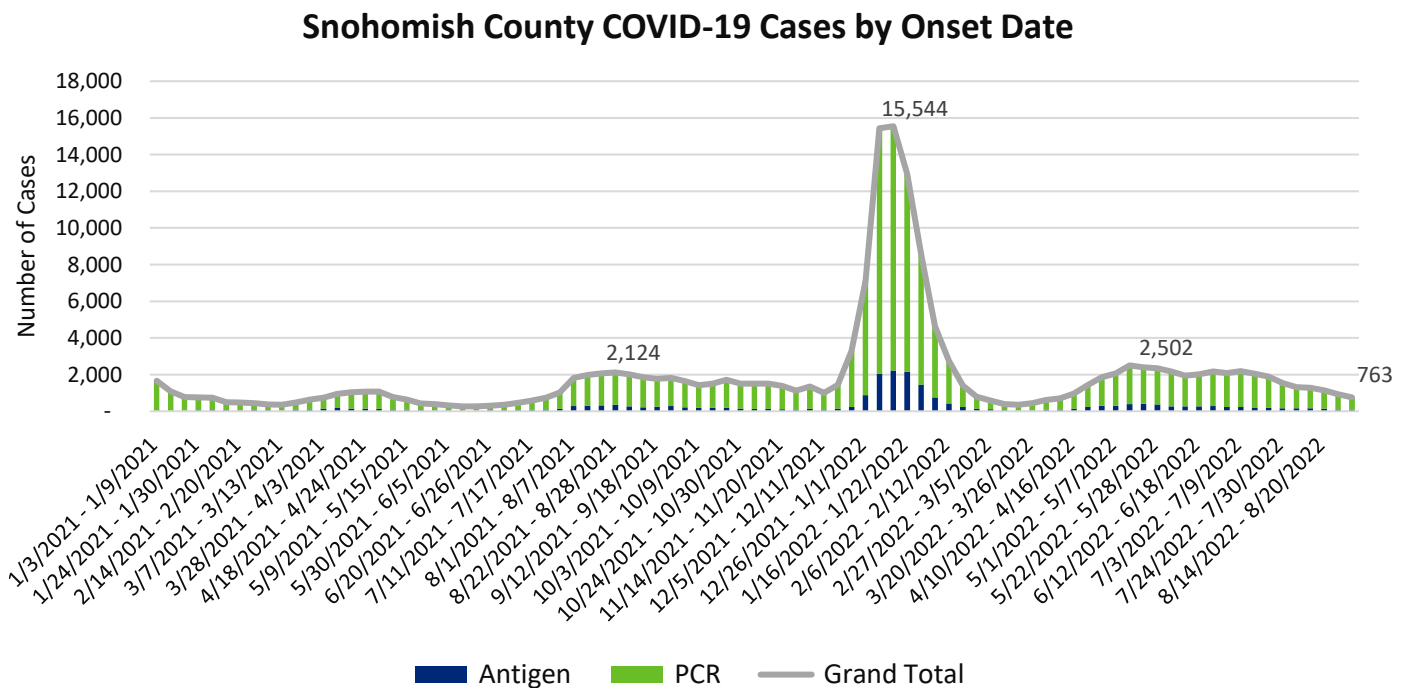


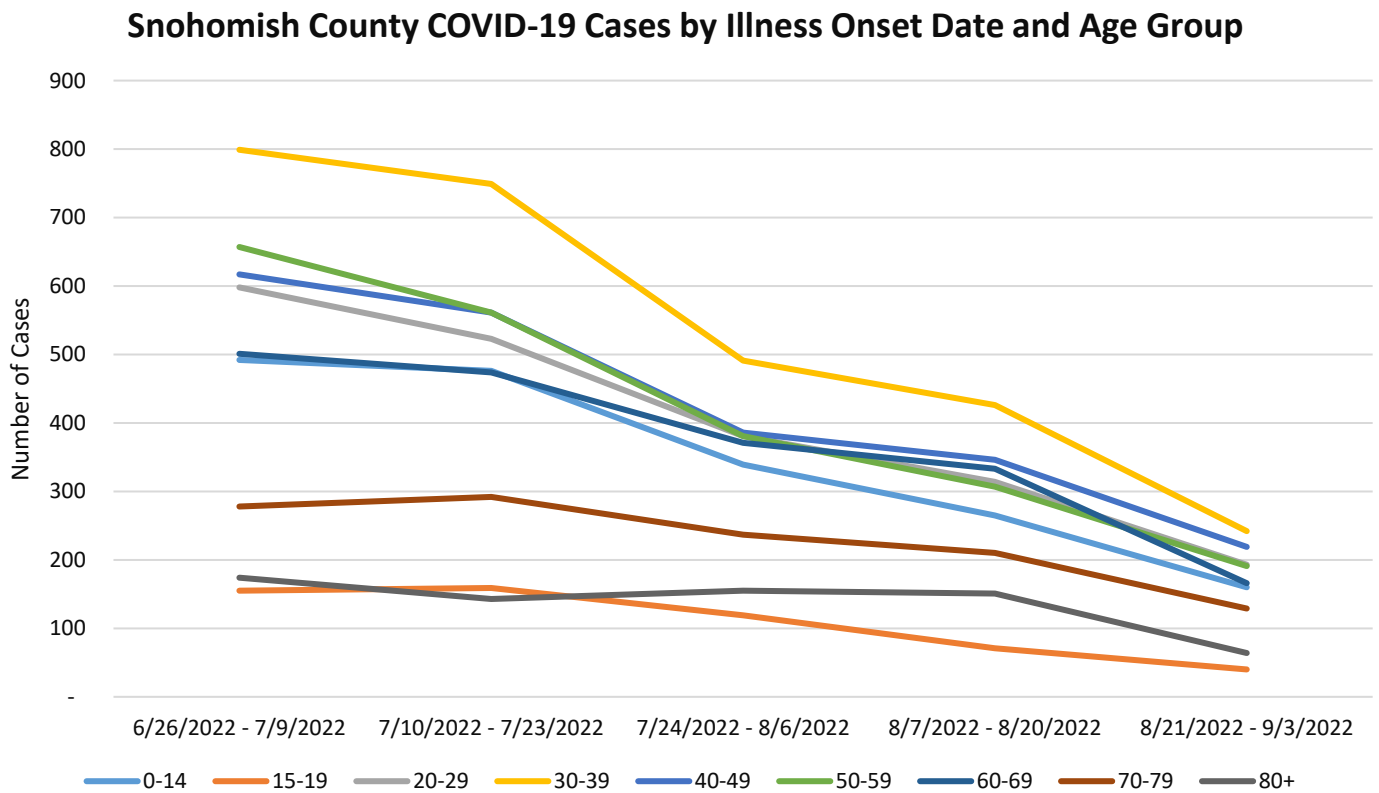
Figure 2: Number of Snohomish County COVID-19 cases by specimen collection date

**Figure 3: Number of COVID-19 cases by illness onset date and age group**

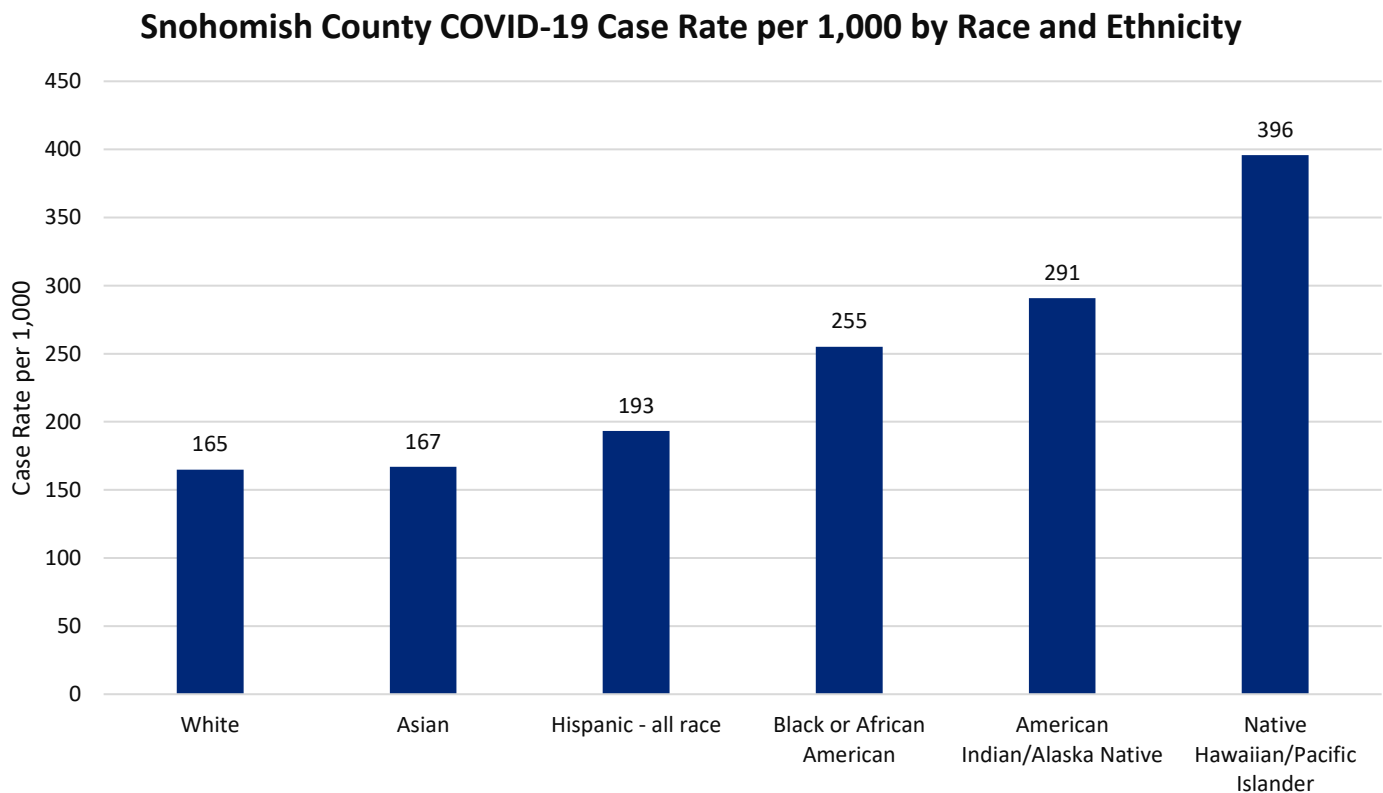

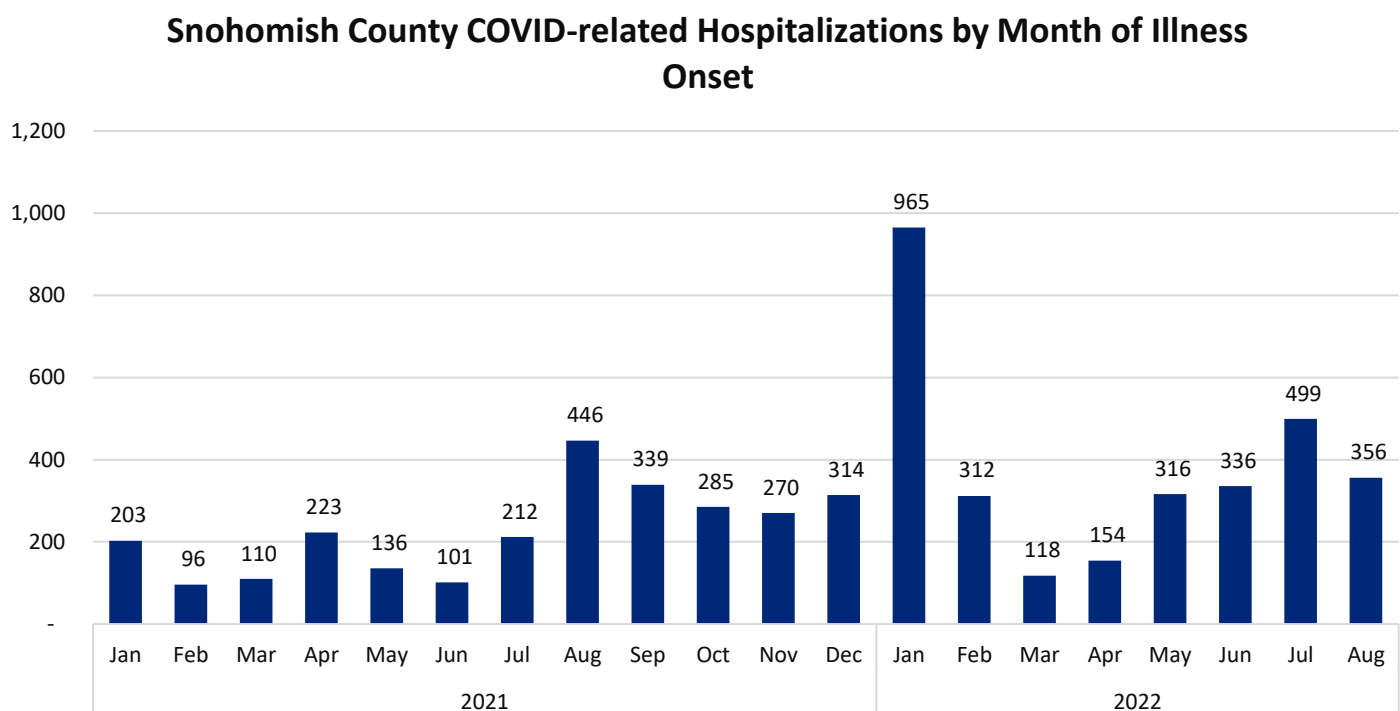

**Figure 5: COVID-related hospitalizations by month of illness onset**

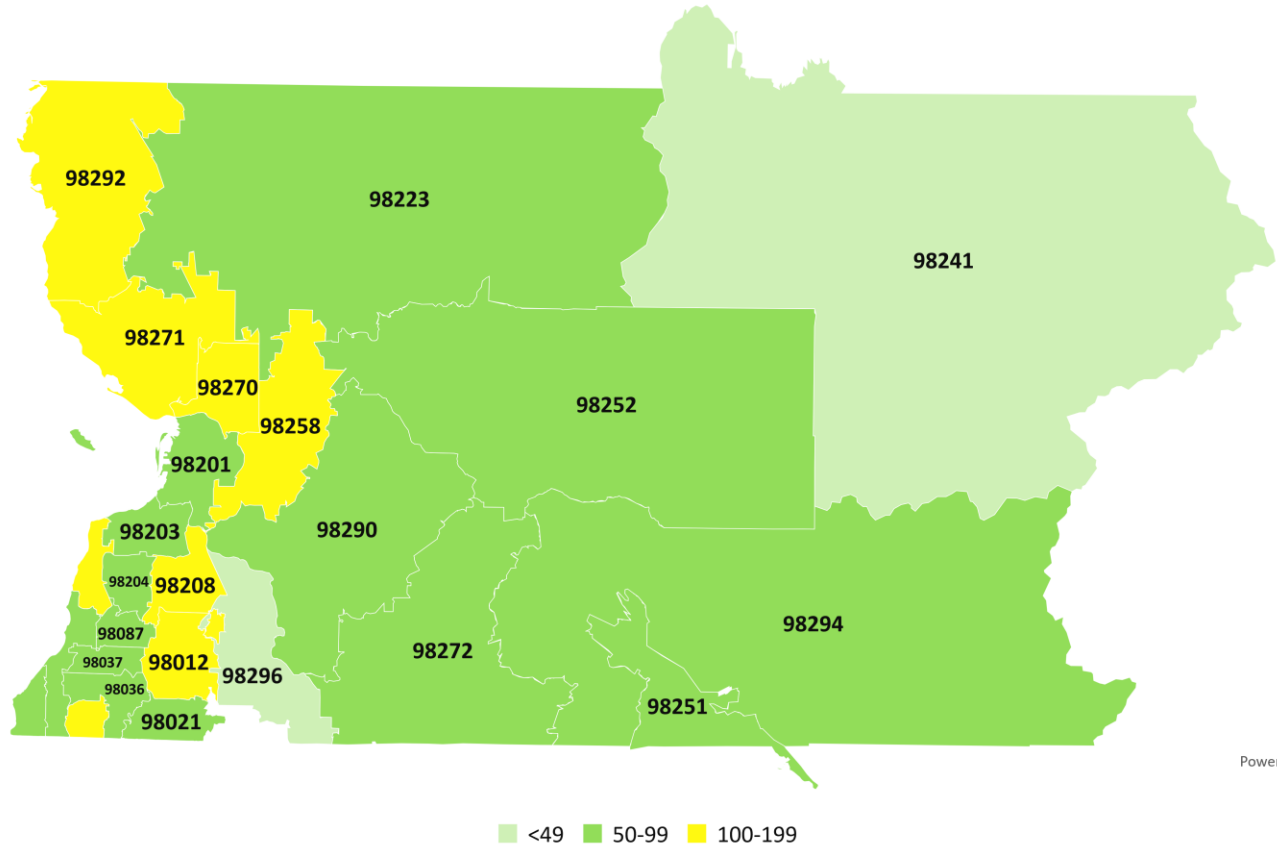

Figure 7: Snohomish County COVID-19 related deaths by date of death

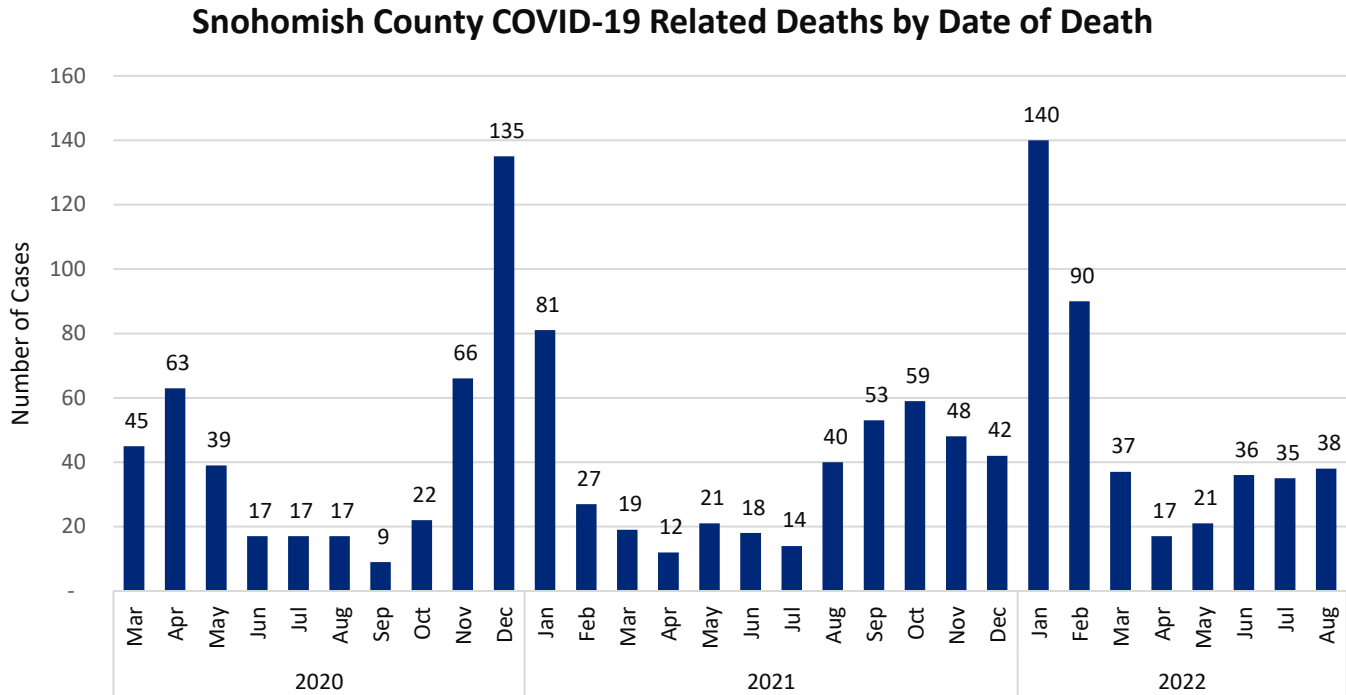

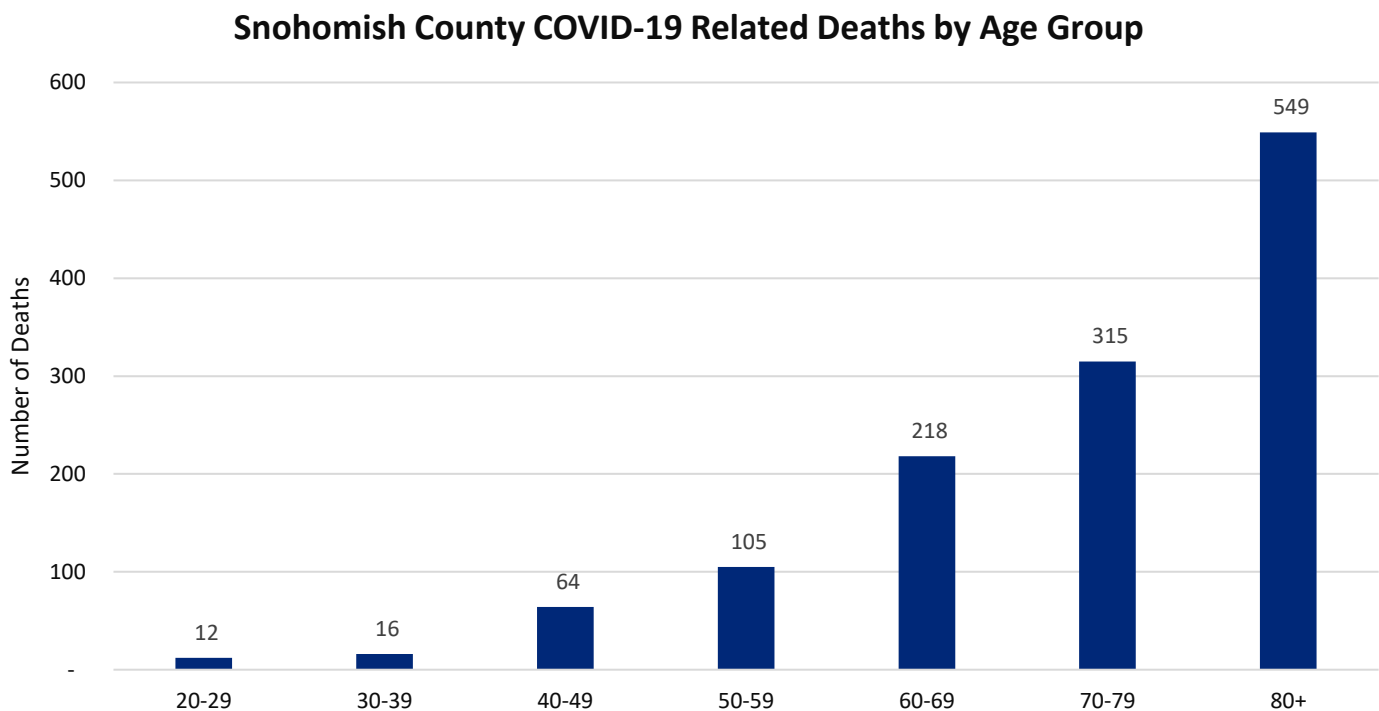
