

INDIVIDUAL WELL APPLICATION PROCESS STEPS



1. Submit an application for an Individual Water Supply Site Inspection and pay the application review fee.

For two connection wells, please contact Snohomish County Health Department.



2. An Environmental Health Specialist will review your well site application for compliance with the Snohomish County Health Department Code.



3. After your well site application has been approved, contact a licensed well driller to drill your well.

4. After you have an approved well site application for a new or existing well, submit a Request for Review: Individual Water Supply Application signed by the property owner/applicant and attach the following documents:

- Water Well Report to verify that the well was constructed per WAC 173-160, including well yield test information per WAC 173-160-321
- Results of inorganic chemical analyses for the elements arsenic, barium, cadmium, chromium, lead, mercury, selenium, silver, sodium, fluoride, nitrate.
- Results of a bacteriological analysis




5. An Environmental Health Specialist will review your Request for Review: Individual Water Supply Application for compliance with Snohomish County Health Department's adequate water supply requirements for issuance of a building permit.
