Homeowners can receive up to \$200 in minor repair rebates each year. If you are not sure what counts as a minor repair when applying for a Savvy Septic rebate, please see the list below. If you are still not sure, please contact us before applying for your minor repair rebate.

You CAN get a minor repair rebate for...

- Baffle replacement or repair
- Pump replacement or repair
- D-box replacement or repair
- Fixing or replacing a cracked transport line
- Effluent filter installation
- Switching to a different lateral in a step down system
- Repair or replacement of alarm system, timer, control panel, or other electrical equipment
- Gallon meter installation or repair
- Charcoal filter installation or replacement
- Headworks replacement or repair
- Correction of a settled transport line

You CANNOT get a minor repair rebate for...

- Mainline jetting/drainfield jetting
- Stress tests
- Cleaning processes (such as cleaning a filter)
- Riser lid replacement (if you already have risers and replace a damaged lid, apply for a riser rebate!)
