

# Septic Permit Steps **Phase 2 of 2**

## Permit & Installation Process Overview

STEP 1



Contact a septic designer or professional engineer. They can help with step 2 and will be needed for step 3.

STEP 2



Complete any permit requirements. Requirements vary and will have been sent with your application approval info. This can include things like fees & additional documentation.

STEP 3



Find a certified installer, then reach out to your designer and request that the permit be issued to the installer you chose.

STEP 4



The system can be installed once the permit has been issued.

STEP 5



The designer does a final inspection and creates an as-built record. The Health Department also does a final inspection and reviews the as-built. If all looks good, it is approved.
