Primary Care & Walk-In Care)</p>	<p>Yes. Our clinics have an Enrollment and Eligibility Specialist on site who is available to answer any questions they may have. We will try to enroll families, or at least children, in Washington Apple Health at the time of appointment.</p>	<p>At our two Walk-In Clinics located at the Lynnwood and Everett-Central Clinics, children can show up during clinic hours and wait to be seen for a new patient appointment for their immunizations.</p> <p>Yes. After this initial appointment, they will be considered CHC patients and can choose any CHC location as their medical home. It is important to establish care with a medical provider so you can ask questions regarding your health care in the future.</p>	<p>Washington Apple Health only covers well child checks (WCC) on an incremental basis. We will work with the patient to see if a WCC is due or not. If a WCC is not needed, the immunizations will be given at no cost.</p>	<p>Yes, but we will ask the families, or at least for the children, to enroll in Washington Apple Health at the time of appointment.</p> <p>If not insured, CHC patients can be billed on a sliding fee scale for services received.</p>

ICHS can provide walk-in immunizations for flu and Tdap to adult patients only, regardless of their status as an established patient. For minor patients or for other immunizations, all new patients need to be fully registered and see an ICHS provider before getting immunizations.	Yes, as long as their Washington Apple Health coverage is active, there is no cost for preventative procedures, including recommended immunizations.	Patients without insurance can apply for the ICHS sliding fee if they wish. Fees and discount levels are determined by a federally mandated sliding fee scale, based on family size and income level. Patients should bring proof of income so we can determine their level of discount.

The Rep can explain the benefits that each company has to offer.	Yes. The first visit can be as a nurse only vaccine visit. For children, we ask that they become established patients and schedule an appointment for follow up care with a primary care provider.	For patients who have active Washington Apple Health coverage, there is never an out-of-pocket cost for immunizations.	Yes. Both adults and children can receive immunizations and be billed according to a sliding fee scale. We will register them to document the visit. Children are asked to become our patients and establish care with a primary care provider.

Yes. They would need to register as our patient to create a chart for the visit.

There is no charge for immunizations given as part of well child check appointments for patients who have Washington Apple Health coverage.	Yes. They would need to register as our patient in order to qualify for the sliding fee scale.
