

## **Amendment #2 to Rucker Building Remodel RFQ 2020-01**

This amendment is made by Snohomish Health District in regards to RFQ 2020-01

The RFQ is amended as follows:

### 1. RFQ Submittals:

Clarifying that proposals submitted by any means other than emailing will not be accepted. Responses will be accepted until 2:00 PM (our clock), Tuesday, 07/07/2020. Proposals submitted after the deadline date and time will not be accepted.

### 2. Corrections to Evaluation Matrix (highlighted):

#### **Evaluation Criteria for the Written Responses**

Each proposal will be evaluated and given a score based upon the quality of response to each of the following topic areas. Maximum number of points achievable is 100.

#### A. Project Timeline– 20 points maximum

- i. Timeline – 20 points
  - Ability to create/monitor project timelines
  - Ability to meet project timelines
  - Ability to exceed project timelines

#### B. Organizational Background, Experience & Expertise – 60 points maximum

- i. Qualifications of Proposed Members – 20 points
  - Years of experience
  - Quantity of similar projects
  - Education
  - Years with the firm
- ii. Comprehension, Responsiveness and Demonstrated Success – 20 points
  - Illustrates that the team clearly understands objectives and technical requirements
  - Responsiveness to all aspects of the RFQ
  - Firm's demonstrated success with similar projects
- iii. LEED Experience and Successes – 10 points
- iv. Public Sector Experiences – 10 points

#### C. Clarity of Proposal – 20 points maximum

- i. Is the SOQ easy to understand?
- ii. Do the graphics further clarify the written items?
- iii. Did the firm (or group) follow the submittal format?
