

**The following questions have been received to date:**

1. Will the new color scheme be the same as the existing? **NO, we will be using three colors on the front of the building and one color on the north wall and back of the building. New scheme shall compliment the surrounding buildings.**
2. What sheen will be applied? **Eggshell**
3. Is there a water source close by for power washing? **YES on both sides**
4. Does the scope include painting the "Snohomish Health District" sign? **YES** It appears to be the same color as the entry accent. **Yes, it is**
5. There appears to be some fairly isolated areas needing stucco repair. Will this be completed by another contractor prior to painting? **We did not plan on a separate contractor for stucco repairs prior to painting. Proposer may address in their proposal.**
6. Does this estimate include tax? **YES**
7. Is there an engineer's price estimate? **NO**
8. Are we painting the South wall that butts up to the apartment building? **We will not be painting the South wall other than an approximately 3 foot wide section on the southeast corner, you should be able to reach that section with the lift you are using for the front of the building.**
9. Do we need a side walk permit for are boom lift? **You will most likely need a sidewalk permit for the boom lift (successful bidder must abide by all City of Everett permit requirements).**
10. Are there two body colors on the back and front walls? **NO, please see question #1**
11. Can we use the roof of the small winery below the North wall? **NO, you will need a swing stage or some other means of reaching the north wall as the winery roof will not be available.**
12. Do we have to use a swing stage? **It is the contractor's responsibility to determine what equipment is necessary to complete the job.**
13. Do you anticipate extending the bid due date? **NO**
14. What additional details are you willing to provide, if any, beyond what is stated in bid documents concerning how you will identify the winning bid? **NO**
