They do not have to be patients of our clinic but will need to fully register so we can look up information and document the vaccines in the Washington State Immunization Information System. We encourage patients to establish care to ensure that they stay up to date with recommended immunizations.	No. If they have active Washington Apple Health coverage, they receive vaccines at no cost.	Yes. Families without medical insurance and not wishing to enroll can receive immunizations on a sliding fee scale. We can also provide a Good Faith Estimate ahead of the visit so patients are aware of the potential cost. We can also administer several vaccines to uninsured adults at no cost. We recommend patients bring proof of income to apply the sliding fee scale appropriately.

Same day appointments are available. We can provide immunizations on a walk-in basis to established patients. New patients would need to establish care with the providers the same day if appointments are available.	There is no charge for immunizations given as part of well child check appointments for patients who have Washington Apple Health coverage.	Yes. They would need to register as our patient in order to qualify for the sliding fee scale.
