

COVID-19 ACTIVITY AND CAPACITY IN SNOHOMISH COUNTY

The Healthy Washington: Roadmap to Recovery announced by Governor Jay Inslee provides a framework for regions to safely ease some restrictions while also maintaining crucial hospital capacity. The Washington State Department of Health (DOH) will compile updated data by region every Friday.

Based on the first dashboard update, the Puget Sound Region is only meeting three of the four criteria and is therefore not eligible to advance yet.

For the week starting January 11, Snohomish County must follow Phase 1 of the new roadmap.
