

# summer suncatchers

## Supplies Needed:

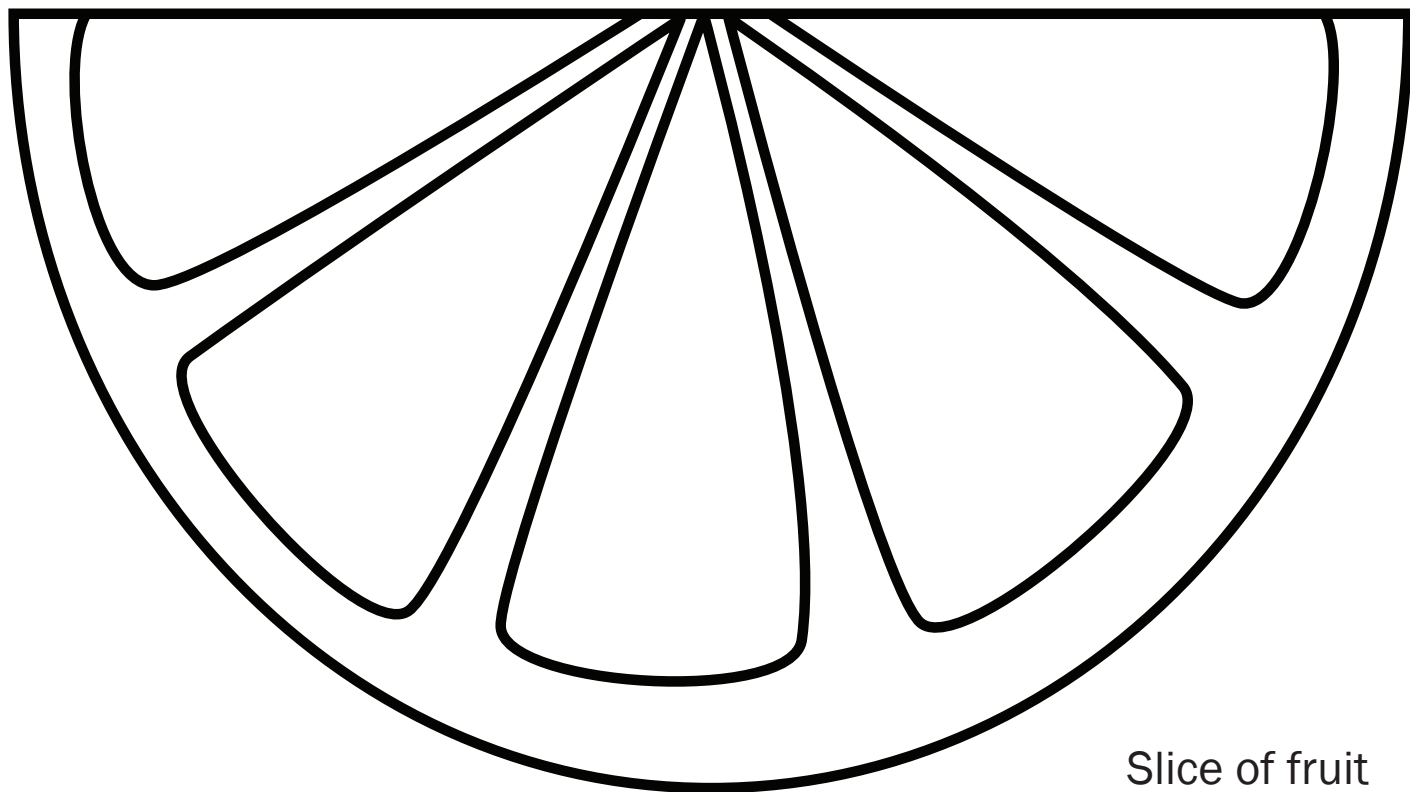
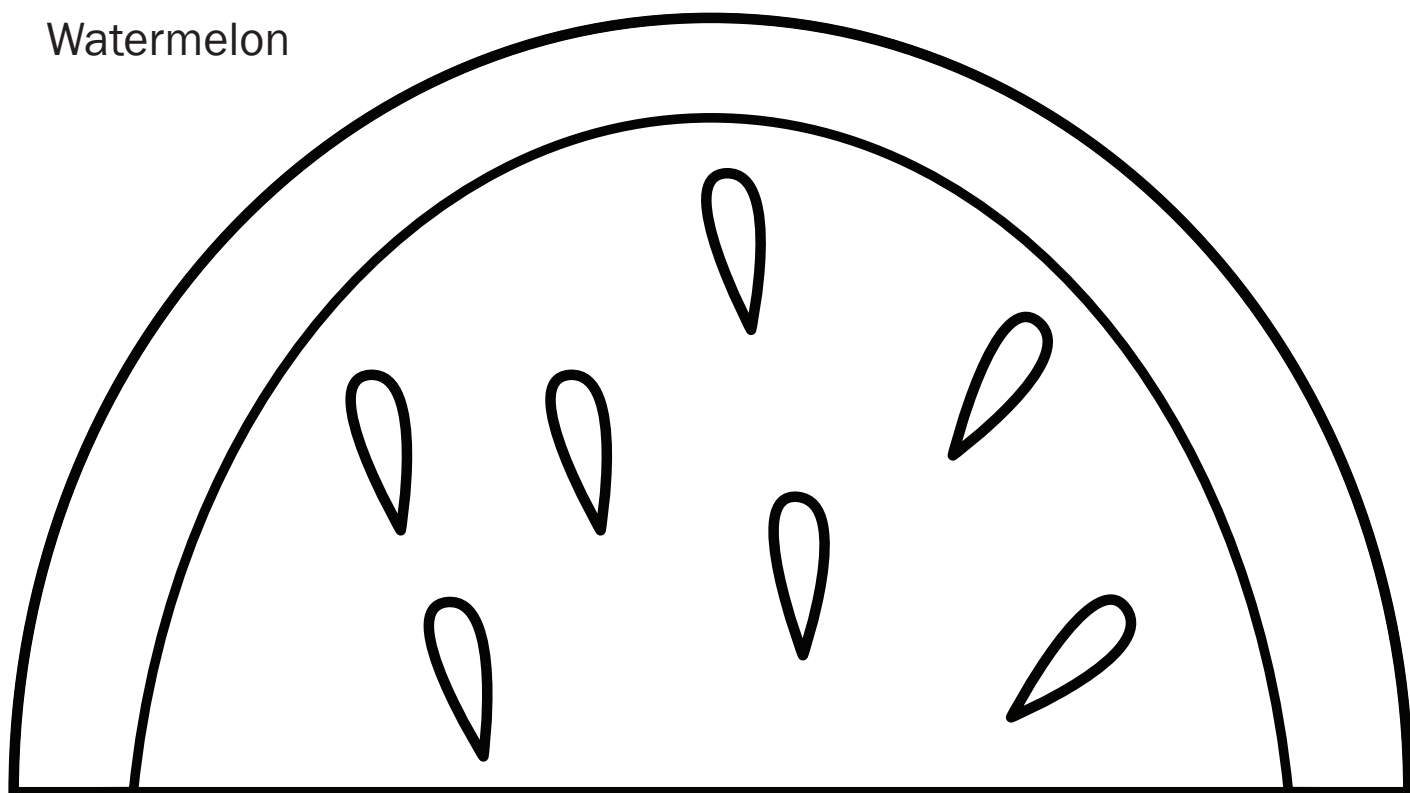
- Tissue paper in various colors as desired
- Scissors
- Clear contact paper
- Tape



## Directions:

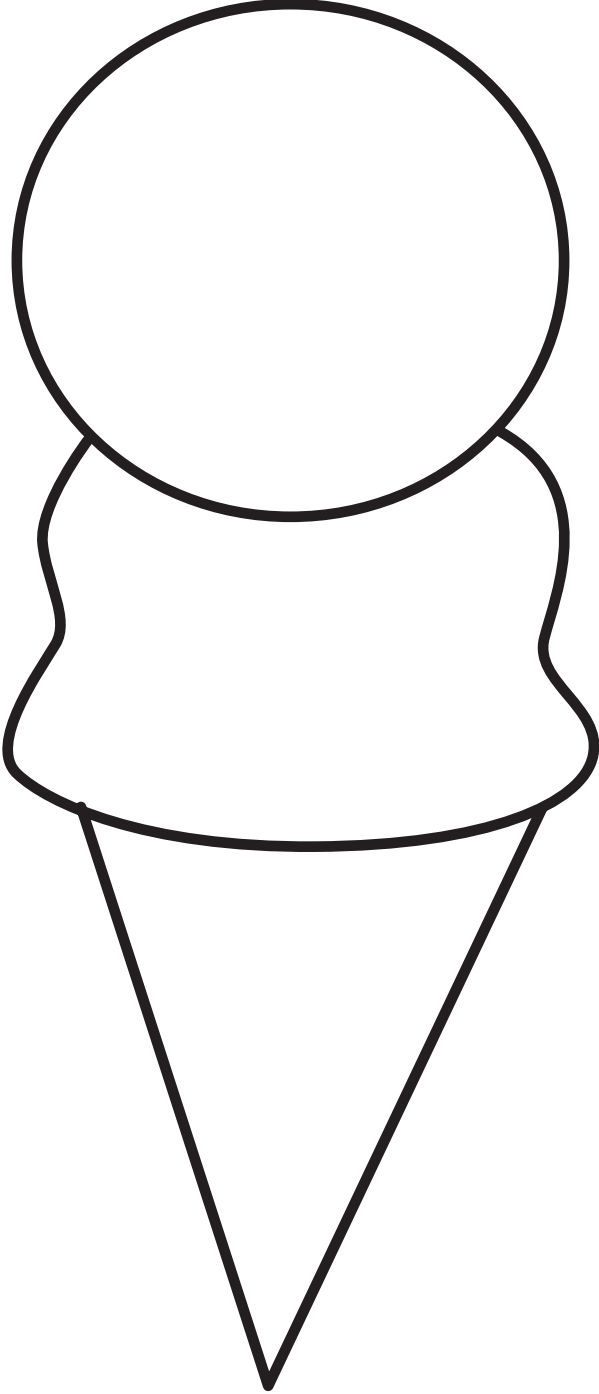
1. Cut tissue paper into small pieces. The size depends on your personal preference.
2. Cut 2 identical pieces of contact paper that will completely cover your suncatcher design.
3. Remove the backing of \*1\* of the pieces of contact paper, laying it down with the sticky side facing up. Tape each corner down to keep the sheet flat and still.
4. Add your tissue paper pieces. Overlap the pieces and fill the entire area of the suncatcher.
5. Take the backing off the other sheet of contact paper and put it sticky-side down onto the tissue paper collage you just created.
6. Cut out your suncatcher's shape. You can also cut out and trace shapes using the attached templates—for watermelon, a slice of fruit (orange, lemon or lime), ice cream cone, and popsicle.
7. Attach your suncatcher to the window with tape, or punch a hole in the top and hang using ribbon or string.
