




Last year in school, were you taught about the following?

- ☐ Consent and healthy relationships?


86% of 10th graders and 63% of 12th graders report never having had sex.

Percent of students who report they've never had sex*



Among those who did have sex, *condoms* were the most common contraceptive method, followed by birth control pills, then IUD or implant. Only 4% of 10th graders and 6% of 12th graders reported using *no method* to prevent STDs or pregnancy when having sex.
